

I. Personal particulars

The undersigned:

1. The Koninklijke Vereniging "Het Friesch Paarden-Stamboek", henceforth referred to as the KFPS, located at Optrijlaan 1, Drachten, The Netherlands, represented by its chairperson, Mr. Roozmond, residing in Bergen, The Netherlands, and hereinafter referred to as the origin studbook,

And

2. Dansk Frieser Forbund, henceforth referred to as DFF, located at Soendergaard Alle 22, DK-6500 Vojens Denmark, represented by its chairperson, Mr. A. Dethlefsen residing in Jylland, Denmark and hereinafter referred to as the branch studbook.

declare themselves agreed to the following:

II. General aspects

1. The *DFF* shall do everything to become recognized by the EU the sole breeding association of the Friesian Horse in Denmark. The KFPS is only able to work with the only EU-recognized association in Denmark, until that time, this 'intention contract' is the confirmation of the relationship between the KFPS and the *DFF*.
2. The KFPS shall recognize the *DFF* as its sole branch studbook in Denmark, beside other EU-admitted associations. All contacts with members in Denmark shall be made through the *DFF* unless the contact is in regard to services that directly involve the KFPS such as stallion inspection, ABFP and approvals of stallions as based on progeny.
3. The *DFF* shall commit itself to adopting the breeding standards, breeding objectives and breeding program of the KFPS in their entirety as well as the registration guidelines of the KFPS and, in its conduct, shall consider the interests of the KPS and the Friesian horse.
4. The members of the *DFF* are direct members of the KFPS and thus have the same rights and obligations.
5. The representation of the members of the *DFF* in the council of members shall be effected through the foreign region 'Other foreign regions'. The representatives of the region shall be elected according to the KFPS regulations.
6. During the term of the agreement, the *DFF* shall be permitted to make use of the pictorial trademarks of the KFPS, including not only the logo of the KFPS and of the World Friesian Horse Organisation (WFHO), but also the stationery of the KFPS and the name 'Phryso' which are all the property of the KFPS. The *DFF* shall discuss the using of the trademarks of the KFPS every time they use the logo for some purpose.
The *DFF* shall not be permitted to establish rights to these or similar brands, logos, trade names, etc. These rights shall expire immediately upon the termination of this agreement.
7. This agreement is being entered into for 2011 & 2012 & 2013 and shall be renewed every two years. Should one of the parties wish to terminate the agreement, this party shall notify the other party in writing by means of a registered letter and shall observe a notice period of one year.

III. Records

1. The DFF shall be responsible for effective membership records. This implies that changes in the membership records shall be updated and forwarded once a month. The KFPS/ DFF shall keep its membership records updated in KOFPAS, the record system used by the KFPS.
2. The DFF shall be responsible for effective ownership records. This implies that transfers be forwarded to the KFPS/updated in KOFPAS¹ as soon as possible. The KFPS/ DFF shall keep the ownership records updated in the KFPS registration system.
3. The KFPS shall print out the studbook papers and send them to the DFF.
4. The papers shall be issued under the auspices of and are¹ the property of the KFPS. The DFF shall commit itself to complying with the procedures and rules of the KFPS with regard to membership, ownership and horse records.

IV. Inspections

1. The DFF shall commit itself to using only those jury members who have been certified by the KFPS. The KFPS shall provide enough jury members for the inspections held in Denmark.
2. The inspection schedule shall be determined by the KFPS in consultation with the DFF. KFPS and DFF shall discuss the program of the inspection and agree about it.
3. An inspection can take place if there are at least 25 registrations. If there are fewer registrations, the possibility of an inspection shall be discussed between the KFPS and the DFF.

V. Finances

1. The KFPS shall invoice the DFF on quarterly basis. The invoicing shall be specified according to cost center. Dutch currency (euros) shall be used for invoicing purposes. The date on the invoice shall determine the rate of exchange. KFPS shall be responsible for that DFF at anytime are updated on prices and charges..
2. Membership fees shall be invoiced in advance. A settlement shall take place at the end of the year as based on the number of members as of 31 (thirty-one) December of every year. The KFPS shall send an invoice for the difference between the payment made in advance and the amount as based on the number of members as of 31 December to the DFF.
3. The DFF shall be responsible for the collection of the fees. KFPS will apply all the needed information about the members to collect the payments and reminders.
4. KFPS will inform DFF about all the direct payments, made by Danish members.
5. The DFF shall settle the invoices by electronic banking.
6. The rates employed by the KFPS shall be identical for all members of the KFPS. These rates shall be indexed annually as based on the Dutch price index. The KFPS shall send its list of rates to DFF every year. The list of rates shall be published in English. KFPS will work out a bonus system for foreign associations, to compensate them (partly) for their work. For determining the value of the bonus, KFPS and DFF have to agree to the purpose of the money, the long term goals of the association and the way to realize the goals.

The normal bonus for the foreign associations:

- for the organization of the inspection, the association receives 80% of the keuring fee
- members outside the Netherlands pay 50% of the Dutch membership fee (if necessary, the association is allowed to raise the membership fee)

'Middle class' associations will get an extra bonus of € 5.000,- for 3 years, counted from January 2011 to improve and professionalize the association. To get this, they have to write a business plan, as appendix 01 to justify the usage of this extra bonus. DFF is a middle class association and will make a business plan to receive this bonus. In the appendix 02 is outlined what KFPS expects from 'middle class associations'.

7. With regard to jury expenses: the travel and accommodation expenses incurred by the jury shall be covered by the DFF. The jury is paid for its time and services by the KFPS.
8. The DFF shall be in default by the mere expiry of the payment term specified in paragraph 1 of this Article or by failing to comply with any other obligation specified in this agreement. The KFPS shall, however, send two reminders in writing before proceeding to any measures.


VI. Provision of information

KFPS is intended to provide studbook and breeding information for its members.


1. The KFPS shall provide information for all of its members on its website and possibly on the website of its branch studbook. This information shall be provided in English. Some of the information such as the inbreeding calculations for horses owned by members and stallion information shall be provided free of charge. Horse data will be provided at cost.
2. The DFF is entitled to translate the articles in *Phryso* at no charge. If desired, the photographs can also be purchased.

VII. Other agreements

1. The language used for communications between the KFPS and the DFF shall be English unless a decision is arrived at by general consensus at a meeting to use another language.
2. The DFF is obliged to create an e-mail address and also to check its mailbox regularly so that incoming e-mails will be answered within one week.
3. Supplementary agreements between the KFPS and DFF can be incorporated in the collaboration agreement and shall be added in the form of an attachment to the collaboration agreement
 - a) Friesian horse owners who have their permanent address outside Holland, engaged themselves to be member of the association where the permanent address is..
 - b) DFF will do their best not to support any kind of cross- and piratebreds
4. Dutch law shall apply to this agreement. Any disputes shall be resolved by the court in the court district in which the KFPS is established.
5. This agreement shall replace any agreements previously made between parties and contains all the agreements currently signed between the parties.
6. In the unlikely event that a provision in this agreement might prove null and void or, on the other hand, not legally valid or not binding, this shall not have any effect on the validity of the other provisions, and the parties shall consult with each other for the purpose of replacing the provision in question with a valid

provision that corresponds as closely as possible in terms of essence and spirit to the provision in question.

Future policy for Dansk Frieser Forbund (DFF)

In Denmark after a few years with a very fast growth the amount of members and horses are now stabile.

For the coming years we have this plan for the association in combination with the work and amount of money from KFPS for expanding the number of members and horses in the coming years also. The goal is to increase both with 10% each year. Below are the future plans for this to goal.

DFF will have the intension to let secretariat be opening hours 2-3 days a week at different times. Here we can assist the DFF/ KFPS members, with all matters concerning questions about Frisian horses, papers and so on.

It will also be a very good opportunity for new people (coming Frisians horse owners and members) to always have the opportunity to get in contact with the association for information, help and assistance from DFF to buy their first Frisian horse.

DFF now have 2 keurings as a minimum for the coming years;

2 keurings are held in Jylland & Sjælland with a total amount of 200 to 250 horses.


1 IBOP test

Sport, in 2008 we started a dressage competition for promotion of the Frisian horse in sport, which was a success. We have 5 dressage-competitions in different parts of Denmark with a total of more than 100 starters.

DFF have now 5 local-associations in Denmark (you can compare it a little bit with the *fokverenigen* in NL) , who arranged a lot of events, clinics and a lot of social things, so we have all kind of offers for the members. Our intensions are to support these 5 local associations, and we don't see any demands from other kind of groups right now, as long as these 5 are working together with DFF, and act under respect for the rules in DFF and KFPS.

DFF have already a well functional website (www.danskfrieserforbund.dk) where we have news from KFPS and about the Frisian horse in Denmark and the rest of the world. On this website we also have a calendar with activities from DFF and the local-associations, a sales list for the members horses, information and breeding goals in general.

The association is already recognised as Frisian horse association from the government in Denmark, and this will be renewed a.s.a.p. after the new contract is signed with KFPS.

We have expanded our board with two people, so we are 7 board members, and the purpose of this is even more contact to our members.

The future plans are, together with this secretariat, to free more time for the board to have the contact with members instead of using all time on paperwork.

Our strategy for the coming years:

- More contact with already existing members and keep them in the "family"- more often board members shall be a part of local events.
- More service for members and newcomers with "openings hours" at the secretariat.
- Improve the information value for first buyers/new members and existing members
- Easier and faster response for member questions, with all information gathered in one place and access to the KFPS-system.
- More marketing for the Frisian horse and the associations (articles, stories and information about what we do; Keuring, sport and so on.)
- More education about breeding and sport- -we already have a Sport- and a Breeding-committee.
- Make it easier to be a DFF/ KFPS member in DK; One membership- and keuring-fee. All invoices come in Danish to understand for everybody.



expectations 'middle class associations'**

- * Organizing inspections, more than one a year for all KFPS-members (also DFF members) in Denmark
- * Possibility for riding an IBOP test at least one time a year
- * Stimulate members to participate on events, like dressage competition or shows
- * Office: have a contact person, which has an email account (read at least every week) and is also reachable by phone once a week (members have to know when!). A part time employee is the best solution
- * website contains a lot of information in Danish, also the translated news items of the KFPS website
- * Administration and finances: done by the association itself: all contacts with the members through the DFF.
- * Prospect: have an own Danish prospect. KFPS will provide information in English and will contribute (partly) the publishing of this prospect
